Day-By-Day Itinerary

Day 1 - Friday March 20th Arrive in Nice, France

Welcome to Nice, France! Meet our assistant and transfer to our hotel in a private coach. Check in at the hotel and rest of the day at leisure. Hotel check in is usually 3PM. In the evening, welcome dinner at the hotel. Overnight in Nice.

Day 2 - Saturday March 21st Cagnes sur Mer & St Paul de Vence day trip from Nice.

Breakfast at the hotel. Meet our guide in the lobby of the hotel and departure for a full day trip of the countryside. Our first stop is **Cagnes Sur Mer**. The **Renoir museum** is placed in the heart of a beautiful estate planted with olive and citrus trees offering a breathtaking view down the Cape of Antibes. It was the retreat and final address of the painter Pierre-Auguste Renoir, who moved to Cagnes to improve his arthritis. The museum's collection; painting, sculptures, artist's studio and furniture constitute the testimony of Renoir's last 12 years of life.

Continue to **Saint Paul de Vence** for a guided tour of the **Maeght Foundation**, a true museum in nature. Lunch on your own at the "Café F" at the museum before the visit. This exceptional site contains one of the most important collections in Europe, with paintings, sculptures; drawings and graphic works of modern art from the 20th century (Bonnard, Braque, Calder, Chagall, Chillida, Giacometti, Léger, Miró, Ubac...) and contemporary artists (Adami, Calzolari, Caro, Del Re, Dietman, Kelly, Mitchell, Monory, Oh Sufan, Takis, Tàpies...). Return to the hotel and dinner in a local restaurant nearby. Overnight in Nice.

Day 3 – Sunday March 22nd : Nice walking tour.

Breakfast at the hotel. This morning, departure from the hotel for a walking tour of **Nice**. Discover with your guide the hidden Baroque churches, awe-inspiring Belle Epoque Palaces, super-cool bars and bistros, and winding medieval alleyways along with grand streets and majestic plazas. If any market is going on that day we will definitely visit it! Lunch on your own and afternoon at leisure.

Tonight, dinner in a local restaurant nearby the hotel. Overnight in Nice.

Day 4: Monday March 23rd : Monaco, Monte Carlo and Eze.

Breakfast at the hotel. Today, full day tour of Monaco, Monte Carlo and Eze. Drive with panoramic view over Nice from Mt. Boron. On the Middle Corniche stop at **Eze**, a medieval perched village with its crafts shops and breathtaking panorama. Guided tour of a traditional perfumery, the true essence of Provence.

Continue to the Old Town of **Monaco** and see the Changing of the Palace Guards at 11:55am. Lunch on your own. Tour of **Monte-Carlo** and drive along the amazing Grand Prix circuit. Free time at Casino Square: enjoy yourselves with luxurious shopping, strolling along stunning gardens, megayachts, chic casinos... or simply watch the "rich and beautiful" in their favourite haunts. On the way back, drive along the spectacular coastline Lower Corniche between Monaco and Nice, which harbors typical Mediterranean villages and modern marinas. Admire the Bay and Citadel of Villefranche. Return to the hotel.

Dinner on your own. Overnight in Nice.

Day 5 - Tuesday March 24th : Optional tour to San Remo

Breakfast at the hotel. Today is free unless you wish to join us for an optional day trip to **San Remo** from Nice. Departure by mini-coach with your guide and enjoy a scenic drive along the coast to San Remo, Italy. We will visit the historic town and the harbor and we will have lunch in a traditional restaurant to taste local food. The option is \$225 per person based on 10 going or you can take the train yourself from Nice to San Remo, Italy. Return to the hotel. Dinner on your own. Overnight in Nice.

Day 6 – Wednesday March 25th : Antibes & Cannes day trip from Nice

Breakfast at the hotel. This morning depart for **Antibes** and visit the famous Picasso Museum. Chateau Grimaldi became the home to the **Picasso Museum** in 1966. Picasso stayed and worked there from mid-September to mid-November 1946. Further works were gifted, entrusted or purchased for the collection from 1952. Major 20th Century artists are presented here: Staël, Hartung, Bergman ... along with works by Germaine, Richier, Miro, Pagès and the Poiriers exhibited on the terrace. Continue to **Cannes**. Lunch on your own. In the afternoon, discover the city of festivals, fireworks and film stars. Stop at the Film Festival Palace to see the stars handprints. There will be time to look around the shops and sandy beaches. You will see the famous Croisette Boulevard, which stretches along the beachfront and is home to exclusive shops and hotels. Return to the hotel. **Farewell dinner** in a local restaurant near the hotel. Overnight in Nice.

Day 7 - Thursday March 26th : Departure

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure from the hotel to the airport for your flight back home. End of our services.

Air arrangements: Fares and schedules are based on regular scheduled carrier service. All applicable airline rules apply and schedules are subject to change. Basic fares do not include fuel surcharges, airport departure taxes, passenger facility charges (PFCs), customs or immigration fees, and excess baggage charges. For mileage accrual information, please contact the carrier directly for details. Air inclusive group packages are non-changeable and non-refundable once deposit has been paid. Rules and fees for canceling and revising airfares vary depending upon the type of airfare purchased. Refundable airline tickets will be processed once the original paper tickets (if applicable) are returned to us via a traceable method of mailing. E-tickets do not need to be returned. Last paper tickets have no refund value.

Tariff, fuel surcharges and Exchange Rate Fluctuations: All prices are quoted using the prevailing rate of exchange between the Euro and the USD from the date the original offer was made. If the rate of exchange changes by more than 4%, Jet Vacations LLC reserves the right to revise the selling rates according to the current exchange rate between the Euro and the USD. Jet Vacations LLC reserves the right to change the price of the tour/program before it commences due to fuel surcharges, currency fluctuations, tariff increases from common carriers and suppliers, etc. If there is a surcharge to be applied such notice will be given no later than 30 days prior to the start of the tour or program.

Cancellation Policies: No charges other than the non-refundable initial deposit are levied for individual passengers cancelling prior to the commencement of Jet Vacations LLC services. However, services which have been prepaid by Jet Vacations LLC on behalf of individual clients maybe non-refundable, non-exchangeable, non changeable and/or maybe subject to a cancellation- change fee (e.g. theater tickets, Train tickets, Airline Tickets, Event Tickets, Passes, Entrance fees etc.).

Full cancellation: Failing to pay the contractual deposits (other than the initial deposit) constitutes a cancellation. In the event of non-compliance with the payment due dates, Jet Vacations LLC shall have the right to demand the Customer to immediately pay the outstanding balance. Payment shall then be received by Jet Vacations LLC within eight days as of the date of Jet Vacations LLC's written request. Should payment not be received within this time limit, the group stay shall be deemed to be cancelled by the Customer. In the event of full cancellation of the agreement by the Customer, which is not justified by Jet Vacations LLC's failure to meet its obligations, cancellation penalties shall be invoiced and calculated as follows:
 Initial deposit**: \$350 off initial deposit is non-refundable.
 Up to 90 days prior departure: additional 25% penalty of the total cost per person.
 From 60 days prior to departure: Non-refundable

** Deposit to hold the space is non-refundable. All subsequent deposits are non-refundable. A passenger becoming a single as a result of a partner's cancellation must pay the single supplement.
NOTE: The following non-refundable fees will be added to the penalty charges listed on the cancellation (full or partial) schedule above: Travel protection premiums. Airline tickets - airline penalties, which may be up to 100% of the ticket value. Refundable airline tickets will be processed once the original paper tickets (if applicable) are returned to us via a traceable method of mailing. E-tickets do not need to be returned. Last paper tickets have no refund value.

Travel protection plan: The Travel Protection Plan may not be purchased after final payment has been made. Insurance premium has to be purchased within 21 days of booking. You understand that the travel insurance is provided by a third party and that all claims will have to be addressed directly with the Travel Insurance Provider.

Itinerary variation: We will make every effort to operate all tours as advertised. Situations may arise, voluntarily or involuntarily, that require changes or exceptions in the airport of departure, the itinerary, land arrangements, hotels, trains or ports of call. On these occasions, we reserve the right to make such modifications and substitute conveyances/hotels as deemed necessary.

Tour Cancellation: We reserve the right to cancel the entire trip (or any component of the trip) for any reason and/or time. In this event, our liability, if any, shall be limited to and liquidated by refunding to each prospective participant the payments made.

Hotel selection: It is the responsibility of the traveler(s) to ensure that the hotels and venues in this proposal are adequate for them. Jet Vacations LLC will not be responsible for room sizes, room air condition, room amenities, room service which vary and differs throughout the world, countries, cultures and hotels. We strongly advise Traveler(s) to peruse hotel rating web sites such as Tripadvisor.com to get an approximate "feel" and "judgment" on each properties, to insure that selected hotels/rooms will be adequate for them. Traveler(s) understand that no refund nor legal claims regarding the selected hotels, venues, rooms and /or services will be possible once this contract has been signed and agreed upon.

Hotels Check-in times: Hotel rooms are usually not ready for check-in until after 3 pm. If your flight is arriving early, especially European flights, you should plan for the day's activity until your room is available. Most hotels will store your luggage until your room is ready.

Hotels Air Conditioning and other amenities: Jet Vacations LLC is not responsible for air conditioning standards or availability, as these factors can vary greatly between properties and countries. Some hotel amenities/facilities are seasonal such as swimming pools, terraces, rooftops etc. and may not be opened or hotels may have renovations during the course of the year. Jet Vacations will not be responsible for hotel renovations, noise and/or closure of certain hotel area – facilities.

Single rooms: The single supplement rate is quoted on the basis that single rooms shall not exceed approximately 20% if the total rooms required, unless otherwise agreed and confirmed. Some hotels may charge a further fee should the group exceed this configuration.

Drinks & Meals Policy: All breakfast include juices, tea and coffee. Contracted lunches and dinners include tea and coffee but unless otherwise stated do not include mineral water, wine, beer or other alcoholic beverages. Where wine is included with a meal it is done so on the basis of house white or red wine. No refunds for meals not taken onboard a cruise ship.

Items not included: Jet Vacations LLC programs do not include items of a personal nature such as laundry, hotel extras, Spa or wellness centers, telephone or Wi-Fi charges and drinks with meals (unless otherwise stated in a proposal). All passengers are responsible for settling such accounts before checking out of each hotel. Hotels, Airport and airline taxes and fees are not included unless specified.

Gratuities: Gratuities are not included to the motor coach driver and tour guide. These are at the participant's discretion. A guideline for gratuities is €2.00 per person per day for the guide and €1.00 per person per day for the driver and €3.00 per day for a driver/guide (one person) operation.

Travel Documents: Travel documents will be sent approximately 2 weeks prior to departure, providing full payment has been received. Jet Vacations LLC is not responsible for lost or stolen documents; therefore, any re-issuance of documents may be assessed their full face value and may include increase in cost. A special handling fee of \$35 will be assessed to bookings that require overnight express delivery. Overnight delivery requests will be accepted up until 2 p.m. Eastern Time, Monday through Friday. No Saturday or Sunday deliveries. Some trip documents are sent as E-Documents by email. For all trip documents, it is your responsibility to check the accuracy of your airline tickets and all other documents. You are responsible to ensure that your full, official name is provided to us at the time of booking, exactly as it appears on your valid passport. It can cost up to \$250 or more per person for a name change or other ticket adjustments, plus any fare increase if applicable, due to re-ticketing. The airline will deny boarding if your airline ticket or documents do not match your passport.
